

PARKS AROUND WESTMINSTER, MD

Westminster Community Pond:



Located at the intersection of Route 97 North and Route 140 West. As you are traveling on Route 140 W, it is the last right before taking the exit for Rout 97 N. It's approximately 10 minutes north from the Ag Center.

This park has a lovely, paved, ½ mile path that goes around the pond. There are a lot of ducks and geese present. Not a place to let your dog swim though.

Fenby Farm Quarry & Lime Kiln Park:



Located off of Route 31 (Old New Windsor Pike) on Tahoma Farm Rd. As you are traveling south on Route 31, you will make a right onto Tahoma Farm Rd. The parking lot will be on your left and the walking path is across the street on your right. It's approximately 10 minutes from the Ag Center.

This park also has a paved walkway that is approximately 2 miles long and travels next to several neighborhoods.

Bennett Cerf Park:



Located at 544 Manchester Rd, Westminster. Just north of the entrance to Westminster Mall. It's approximately 8 minutes north from the Ag Center.

There is a stream there that I'm sure our Leo's would love to frolic in!

Located within the park is the Heritage Tree Trail, which encourages visitors to appreciate the trees in the Bennett Cerf Park. This collection represents trees of exceptional size, age, and horticultural value - see
